TEAM MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION/REQUEST FORM

Welcome to California Stars Soccer Club. Our organization was created to promote a competitive level of youth soccer and training for talented youth soccer players. The mission of California Stars Soccer Club is to provide year round club competition for the serious youth soccer players, in a positive learning environment.

The official name of this organization is California Stars Soccer Club. Our soccer club is a member of the California Youth Soccer Association South (CYSA-S) and competes in the Coast Soccer League, State and National Cup and CYSA-S sanctioned tournaments.

Pathway to Membership

New forming and returning team's League Applications for 2009-2010 season will be available online at www.coastsoccer.com after April 15, 2009. The team Administrator/Coach can print the application form from the Coast Soccer League website and submit it along with the entire team and player's membership fees to a California Stars Soccer Club representative by May 10, 2009.

The team Administrator/Coach may also print, fill-out and submit the California Stars SC REGISTRATION & RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM for each individual player available online at www.Californiastars.org.

Returning Teams repeating an age group will be bracketed as a "new" team.

Returning Teams leaving their Club:

- a. If 7 or more returning players (6 for U9-U10) stay with the Club, the Club will keep the bracketing status, the 4-digit team number, and the Bond. The team leaving will apply as a new team, with a new team number, and a new Bond.
- b. If less than 7 players stay with the Club (6 for U9-U10), and 7 or more move to a 'new' Club, the team moving will retain the bracketing status, the 4-digit team number, and work out of the Bond with the original Club.

A Home field is required by Coast Soccer League for any team or club to be accepted. Minimum 6 games must be assigned to a full sided field to accommodate referees. New teams who want to play club soccer must join with a Club/League in their area, or join with other independents to make an Association of 6 (U11-U19) or more teams.

There are two California Stars Soccer Club Team Membership options: The **SILVER GOAL** and the **GOLDEN GOAL** Option (see details below).

California Stars SILVER GOAL Team Membership Option.

Team Membership Cost breakdown and Due Date:

Coast Soccer League Team fee of \$425; a bond fee of \$150 (bond fee is required for new teams), due on or before May 10, 2009.

California Stars Soccer Club individual player fee of \$170 per player

Player Fees plus Player Registration paperwork for the 2009-2010 season due on or before June 15, 2009

Team may have up to 18 (up to 22 for U16-U19s) registered players. New players may be added at any time during the year and individual player fee of \$170 is due for each player as they are added.

Checks should be made payable to California Stars Soccer Club.

California Stars GOLDEN GOAL Membership Option.

Includes:

- Team and individual Player Registration with California Stars Soccer Club, Coast Soccer League, CYSA
- Insurance coverage through CYSA
- Use of California Stars Soccer Club field and equipment for official home league games.
- Basic club operational costs required for team's membership
- Use of California Stars SC Non Profit Federal tax ID to conduct all your team business
- California Stars Soccer Club home field and equipment for twice weekly two hour practice time slots
- Practice Field Insurance
- Team Website

Team Membership Cost breakdown and Due Date:

Coast Soccer League Team fee of \$425; a bond fee of \$150 (bond fee is required for new teams), due on or before May 10, 2009.

California Stars Soccer Club individual player fee of \$280 per player

Player Fees plus Player Registration paperwork for the 2009-2010 season due on or before June 15, 2009

Team may have up to 18 (up to 22 for U16-U19s) registered players. New players may be added at any time during the year and individual player fee of \$280 is due for each player as they are added.

Checks should be made payable to California Stars Soccer Club.
